In year 2 this week we have continued learning about microhabitats - it was very interesting to compare the different species of bugs we found under fallen logs in the forest area after it had rained.

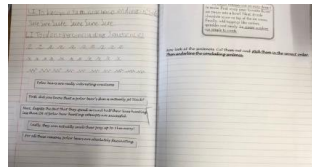
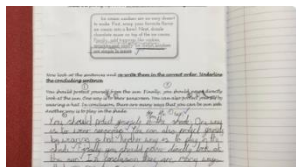


## Year 3 News
