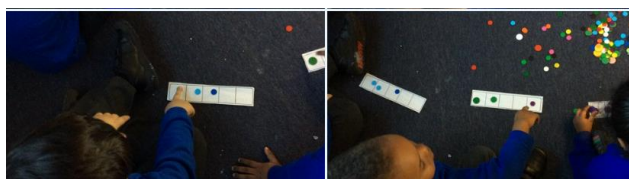
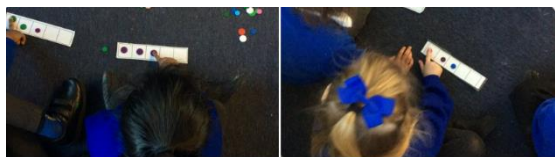
Community Cupboard

Take a look at what Nursery have been doing in Maths this week. They have started counting out objects onto their five frame.



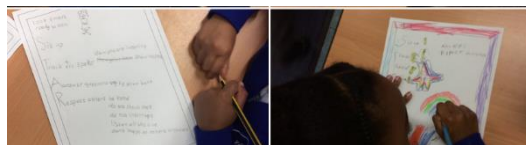
Reception

Year 3 have been investigating friction! We tested different surfaces to see which had the most friction - it was the bubble wrap!



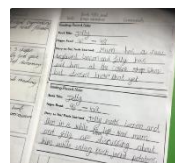
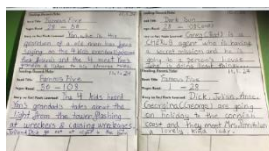
Year 4 News
