Community Cupboard



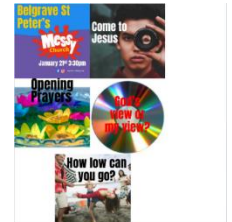
The Community Cupboard is open again on a Monday afternoon 1:30-3 in the Function Room at the Tom Hoskins pub.
