This week in reception we have been exploring different environments, talking about their similarities and differences. We have also been talking about the different animals that live there and why they would not like different places around the world.



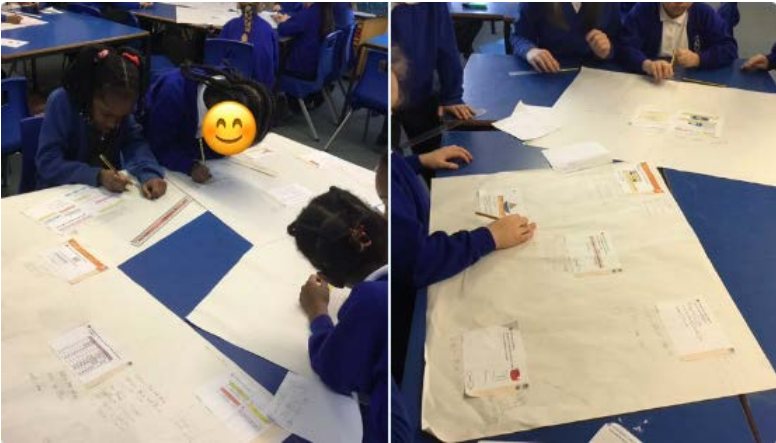
### Year 1 News

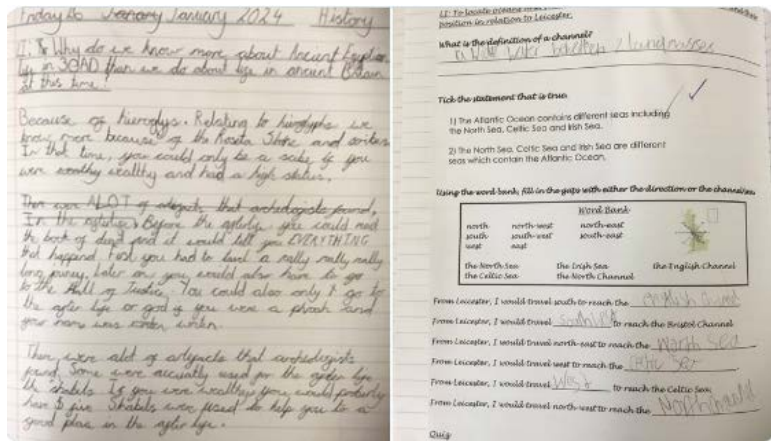
Year 3 News

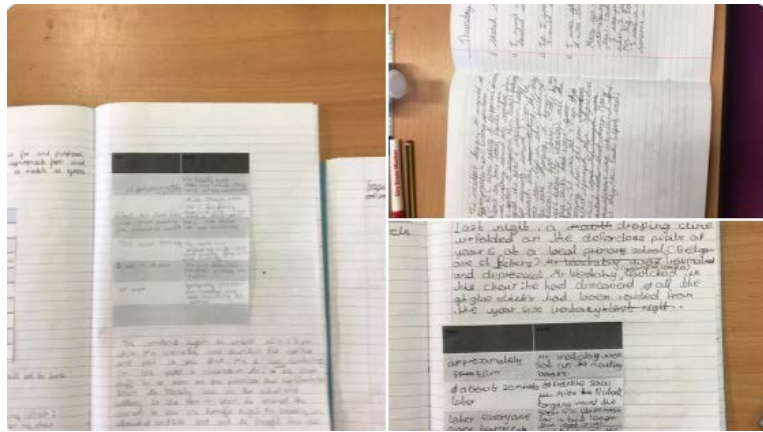
Year 5 News
