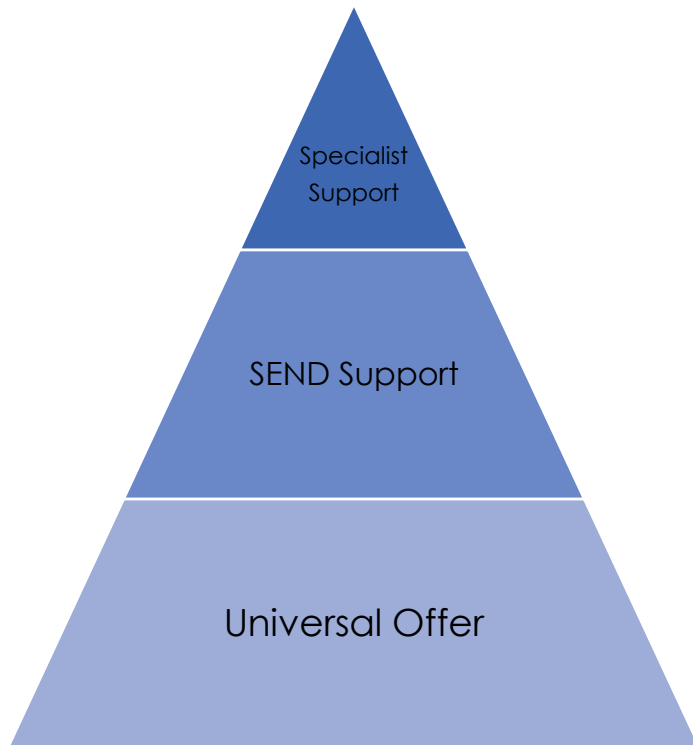


## What is included in the different levels of support at Belgrave St Peter's CofE Primary School?



### Specialist Support

This level of support is in place for children with higher level needs that are long-lasting and have a significant impact on the child's ability to access learning.

- Bespoke and personalised curriculum
- Increased adult support
- Alternative learning environment
- Alternative provision (external)
- Involvement from external professionals

### SEND Support

This support is targeted and given to children with an identified special educational need or disability. The aim of this provision is to enhance progress and support access to learning.

- SEN-specific interventions such as ELSA, Precision Teach for Reading, Colourful Semantics etc.
- Targeted additional support from adults
- Adjustments made in the classroom to Quality First Teaching

### Universal Offer

All children in the school have support to overcome short-term barriers and to ensure access to a broad and balanced curriculum.

- Quality First Teaching
- Curriculum-focussed interventions
- Supportive and nurturing environment
- After school clubs / Breakfast club
