We do not accept Crocs/Sandals, coloured or labelled trainers as these are not safe footwear for children to run and play in on playtimes.

- Earrings should be **studs only**, and we discourage the wearing of any other jewellery and hair accessories.
- Make up and nail varnish/nail extensions should not be worn to school.
