Absence procedure

If you decide that your child is unable to attend school due to illness, the following procedure applies:

- If a child is absent from school, parents should contact the school on the 1st day of absence by 9.00am to inform the school of the reason for absence.
- Parents are expected to maintain contact with the school **every** morning throughout the absence.

It is school's decision whether to accept a reason for a child's absence and whether to authorise that absence. In the majority of cases, a parent's note explaining that their child was ill can be accepted without question. Further evidence of a child's illness may be requested if their attendance is an ongoing concern.
