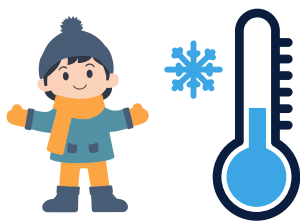
Reminder: Coats and Spare Shoes Needed

The session will end with a member of staff reading a story to the children and parents.

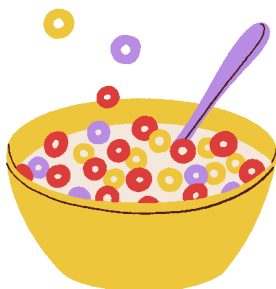
Breakfast Club

Free spaces available for pupil premium children. Entry to the club will be via the main gates on Thurstaston Road



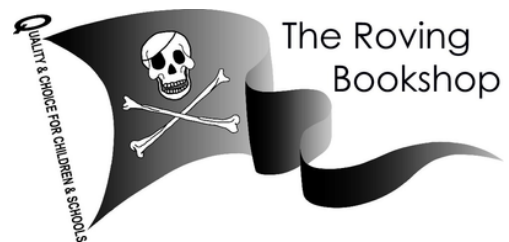
PE Kit and days
