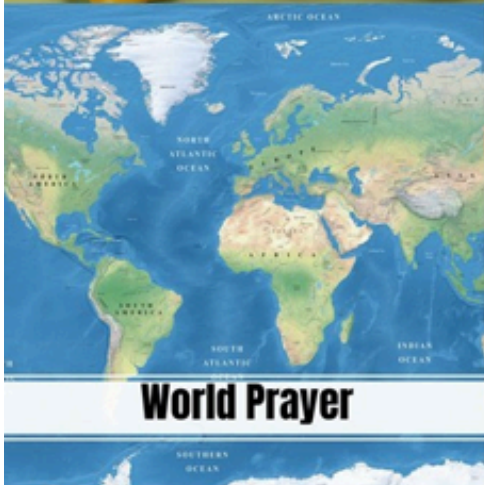
The session will end with a member of staff reading a story to the children and parents.
