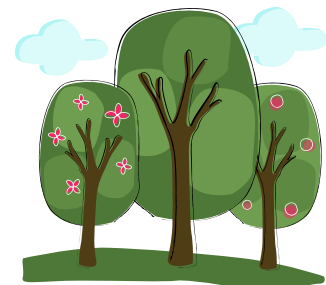
Nursery - 96%

Please ensure your child comes to school with a coat and wellies as the children do go out in all weathers.



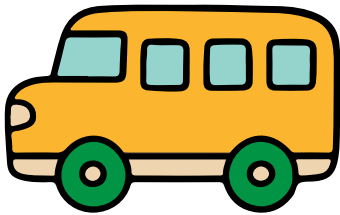


Book Bus
