## Online Safety and TikTok Use

As part of our ongoing commitment to keeping children safe online, we would like to remind you about the importance of monitoring your child's use of social media platforms, particularly TikTok.

TikTok is hugely popular with young people, but it's important to make sure they're using it safely. Here are some simple steps you can take at home:

- **Check the age limit** – TikTok is for **ages 13 and up.**
- **Set accounts to private** – this helps keep your child's videos and profile safe from strangers.
- **Use Family Pairing** – this feature lets you link your account to your child's and manage screen time, content filters, and messaging.
- **Turn on Restricted Mode** – it helps block inappropriate content.
- **Talk regularly** – ask what they're watching, discuss online challenges, and remind them never to share personal details.

Children can spend a lot of time on TikTok, so setting healthy limits is important. 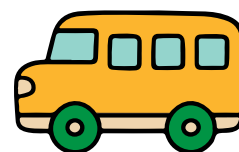


## Book Bus
