Our PE kit consists of:

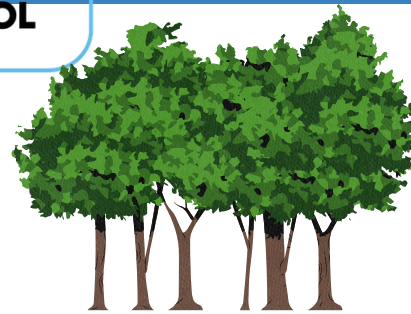
A plain white t-shirt
